Mr. Cunningham;

The El Gheko Neighborhood Association members present at the November 4, 2015 meeting passed a motion unanimously that I send a formal letter under the El Gheko letterhead to you regarding the total lack of progress and/or any communications regarding the traffic situation at the Kolb/Rosewood intersection.

I had met with Ted Prezekski and an employee of the Planning and Development Department at the Ward 2 office regarding the situation last spring after the May N.A. meeting. That employee, whose name I do not remember, thought the problem was not bad as some traffic could use a south exit and go to Broadway at Prudence and then use Broadway instead of making left turns from Rosewood onto Kolb. He was not aware of the lack of such a exit route from the Gateway Business Park.

After finally getting him to realize there are only two exits from the business park, and that only the Rosewood exit allows for left turns, he said he would do a traffic study. Nothing has been heard from anyone since that meeting.

The El Gheko membership is disturbed and feel that we have either "*not been kept in the loop*" or that the concerns "*have been ignored*" (member's words).

Please let me know what the current status is on this issue so I may report it to the membership at our February 4, 2016 meeting at Hudlow School.
