SUBJECT: Residential Street Pavement Rehabilitation Project

Dear Neighbor,

Communication is a key component in creating and preserving partnerships between citizens and the City of Tucson. In keeping with this long-standing commitment, the City of Tucson Department of Transportation (TDOT) is notifying you of an upcoming repaving project that will take place in the Neighborhood bounded by Speedway Boulevard on the north, Kolb Road on the east, Broadway Boulevard on the south, Jessica Avenue on the west in the southern portion of the neighborhood, and Mann Avenue on the west in the northern section of the neighborhood.

Sunland Asphalt, under contract with TDOT, is scheduled to start work on this project in about 12 days. The project will begin with crews performing weed eradication and trimming tree branches overhanging the roadway. Crews will then begin removing a thin layer of asphalt with a micro mill. Crews will then asphalt patch sections of the roadway and apply a double chip seal followed by a fog seal. Crews will work Monday through Friday, from about 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day.

The project is scheduled to be complete by the end of June 2018. The schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or equipment malfunction.

Please note that vehicles cannot be parked on the roadway when crews are working on your street. There should be no major impacts to your property, but there will be driveway access restrictions when heavy equipment is in front of your house and immediately following the application of the chip seal and fog seal.
